AGENDA ITEM 9.1 ELECTION OF PARISH COUNCILLOR

1. Report

- 1.1 As members are aware, Cllr Halsey's resignation from the Parish Council as a result of moving home out of the parish meant that the vacancy had to be advertised on parish noticeboards. As a result of the initial advertisement, 12 persons wrote to Cheshire East Council requesting that an election be held to select a new councillor. Consequently, a second notice was required to be published requesting any person who wished to submit for election to submit their details to CEC.
- 1.2 1 person – Mr R Barrett – has done so and therefore has been elected unopposed to the position.
- 1.3 Because a full election procedure was not required, the Parish Council will not be requested by CEC to fund the election process (as would have been the case had more than one person submitted themselves for election).

2 Recommendation
