1. INSURANCE

Joan Webb, Chairperson, had called this extra meeting of the Parish Councillors, to finalise the acceptance of the Insurance for the Council, and also to inspect 3 sets of planning applications, the replies for which were due shortly to Cheshire East.

Councillor P Gough had obtained a quote from an alternative company than the one used over the past few years This quote was from Came & Company. The quote does not include the insurance that will be needed if the Council take over the Playground Area on Clover Drive. This quote was considerably less than Allianz (present company) and covered everything they covered, with additional benefits. It included the option to have a 3 year long-term agreement giving a 5% discount, and a further 5% No Claims discount to each claim free year up to a maximum of 4 years or 20%.

PG proposed that the Council take up this Insurance with Came & Company, and this was seconded by VB. PG will contact the company tomorrow, 1^{st} June, to verbally inform them that this has been agreed, and then they will send details, and invoice. The cost will be £1,170.41.
