AGENDA ITEM 9.6 POSSIBLE EXTENSION OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN PICKMERE VILLAGE

1. REPORT

- 1.1 One of the actions arising from Council's discussion of how to mitigate the numbers of summer visitors to the village/lake was to try to bring about a dialogue with CEC about the potential merits/demerits of extending parking controls in Pickmere village. After several years of trying, a meeting has finally been held with a highways officer.
- 1.2 The discussion concentrated on three aspects:
 - How to get the faded yellow lines on Park Lane repainted;
 - The possibility of imposing double yellow lines on key road junctions;
 - The possibility of a wider scale approach to yellow lining in the village in an attempt to deter the numbers of visitors to the lake that currently arrive on busy days.
- 1.3 An oral explanation will be given of some of the issues that were covered and the conclusions of the meeting.
